Club Photographer: Take photos at Club events for website and social media use.

Group Event Organizer: Coordinate volunteers for group event requests, collect donations, and have guests sign an Insurance Waiver.

Group Event Volunteer: Set-up rink(s) for play, provide instruction and assist guest players, put equipment away at the end of the event.
